(Escambia County, Florida) On November 10, 2022, Circuit Court Judge Coleman Lee Robinson sentenced Robert James Pooley to a total of thirty-five years in Florida's Department of Corrections for charges of Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon, Trafficking in Methamphetamine, and Failure of a Sexual Predator to Register.

In May of 2021, the Defendant failed to register as required by his sexual predator designation. Consequently, law enforcement officers located and arrested the Defendant for his failure to register. At the time of his arrest, the Defendant was in possession of a firearm and a trafficking amount of Methamphetamine.

The arrest and investigation were conducted by the Escambia County Sheriff's Office. Assistant State Attorney Jessica Etherton prosecuted the case on behalf of Ginger Bowden Madden, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit of Florida.
