On November 3, 2021, the Defendant went to the home of the victim where he pepper sprayed the victim and then engaged him in a physical fight. The victim went towards a neighbor's house to contact law enforcement, at which time the Defendant took out a firearm, and shot the victim through the hip. On January 13, 2023, the Defendant was found guilty as charged by a jury.
