Ginger Bowden Madden, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit of Florida, announced that on March 6, 2023, Justin McCall was adjudicated guilty and sentenced to twenty years in the Florida Department of Corrections.

Between the dates of October 29, 2022, and January 4th, 2023, the Defendant burglarized several vehicles in Crestview, which resulted in a total of 13 charges. In addition to stealing miscellaneous items from the vehicles he burglarized, McCall stole a firearm from an unsecured vehicle. McCall then proceeded to burglarize another vehicle with the stolen firearm in hand. While rummaging through that vehicle, McCall accidentally discharged the firearm and shot himself in the leg which resulted in McCall pleading for help from the very person whose vehicle he had just burglarized. Once on scene, Law Enforcement discovered not only that McCall was in possession of stolen items, but he was also wearing articles of clothing that he had recently stolen from other vehicles. At the time of the offenses, McCall was on probation for Grand Theft of a Firearm.

McCall was sentenced by Senior Judge Rasmussen to twenty years in the Florida Department of Corrections. McCall will serve his twenty-year prison sentence day-for-day with no gain time, pursuant to Florida's 10/20/life Statute.

The investigations were conducted by the Crestview Police Department and the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office. Assistant State Attorney Leah Glisson prosecuted the case on behalf of Ginger Bowden Madden, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit of Florida.
