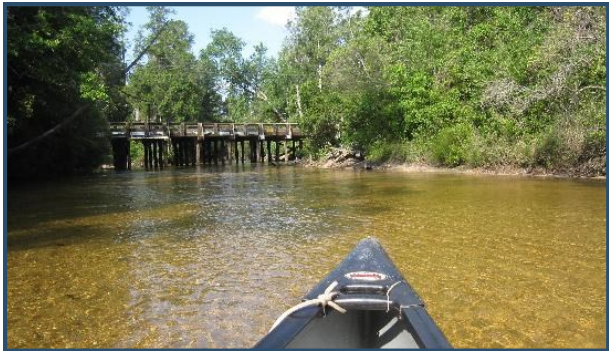

### EDUCATION & PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Public Service Loan Forgiveness Program

### INSURANCE
